Appendix 2: Codebook

1. Number of article

We number each item so we can identify them more easily. For example, '543'.

2. Title of article

We note the main title of the article for identification. This can simply be copied and pasted.

3. Paper

We note which newspaper the article comes from. We have five options: *De Morgen*, *De Standaard*, *De Tijd*, *Het Laatste Nieuws* or *Het Nieuwsblad*.

4. Date of publication

We note the date on which the article was published. For example, '27/11/2019'.

5. Period

We make a distinction between three periods: ‘election’ (26 February to 26 May 2019), ‘coalition’ (1 October to 31 December 2019) and ‘regular’ (15 August to 15 November 2021).

6. Politician

We note which politician is mentioned in the article. If more than one is mentioned, we indicate several options. There are nine possibilities.

7. Gender of politician

We note the gender of the politician, that is, *male* or *female*.

8. Number of mentions

We note how often the (first) name of a politician is mentioned throughout the article.

9. Name is mentioned in title

We note whether the name of the politician is mentioned in the title.

10. Article refers to private life

We note any reference to the marital status of the politician. This includes, but is not limited to, ‘single’, ‘married’, ‘divorced’ or ‘widow’. We note any reference to the role of the politician as a *mother* or a *father*. This includes the mention of kids as well.

11. Article stresses gender

The explicit mention of gender includes terms such as ‘man’, ‘woman’, ‘gentleman’ and other similar words. A combination of two or more words, such as ‘leading lady’ or ‘poster boy’, and references in a foreign language are included.

12. Article refers to appearance

We note any reference to appearance. This includes, but is not limited to, the nationality, presence, haircut and costume.

13. Article refers to age

We note any reference to the age of the politicians. This includes, but is not limited to, stating the exact age or references such as ‘young’ and ‘old’.

14. Article refers to personality traits

We note whether a reference is made to the personality of a politician. The distinction is made between typical female characteristics (warmth, care, kindness) or typical male characteristics (assertiveness, perseverance). If mention is made of personality traits that are traditionally not linked to a specific gender, we choose the option ‘neutral’.
